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JUDICIARY LEADS CLEAN-UP AND RECOVERY DRIVE FOR COURTS AND STAFF IN WESTERN JAMAICA

KINGSTON: JAMAICA: The Judiciary of Jamaica will be executing a Hurricane Disaster clean-up and relief exercise for the Courts and court staff beginning with Hanover, St James and Trelawny on Wednesday, November 5, 2025.

Teams will be deployed to each of these parishes to assist with the clean-up of court facilities and surrounding areas, working to restore operations and provide meaningful support to staff affected by the passage of Hurricane Melissa.

As part of this recovery effort, the following courts will be closed on Wednesday, November 5, 2025:

- The Supreme Court in Kingston
- The Parish Courts in Portland, St. Mary, Clarendon, and St. Thomas

There will be skeletal staff to facilitate emergency issues as the need arises. All courts will be reopened on Thursday, November 6, 2025.

The Judiciary extends its appreciation to all members of staff, the legal community, and the public for their patience, cooperation, and resilience during this period. We remain committed to ensuring the efficient and timely administration of justice as operations gradually return to normal.
