SUSPENSION OF BAIL REPORTING CONDITIONS DURING HURRICANE MELISSA

Kingston: Jamaica: The Judiciary of Jamaica is advising that in anticipation of the effects of Hurricane Melissa, the reporting conditions for all persons on bail are suspended with immediate effect. Bail reporting conditions resume on Monday, November 3, 2025.

This temporary suspension applies islandwide and is intended to ensure the safety of all concerned, given the potential for hazardous weather conditions, blocked or damaged roads, and other disruptions associated with the hurricane.

The Judiciary is urging all stakeholders including the Jamaica Constabulary Force (JCF), members of the public, the private Bar, and persons on bail to take note of this advisory and follow the guidance provided.
